

## History:

- 1) July 2007... Bill and Annie Malone helped a young man survive a suicide attempt (from hospital emergency, to rehabilitation, through effective mentoring, and onto restoration and self-sufficiency).
- 2) August 2007...We organized under what we felt was an appropriate title, "Operation Living Hope" (OLH).
- 3) Along the way we have initiated family events and programs to promote peace in homes.
- 4) May 2010...Compassion grew for those afflicted in bondage to poverty, homelessness, hunger. We formed a thriving Operation Living Hope Food Shelf in inner city North Minneapolis. Food was dispensed an average of 10K lbs. to 800 North Mpls. residents per month.
- 5) March 2014...The North Mpls. Community attaining critical mass for hunger relief, we transitioned the food shelf responsibilities over to Family Food Shelf in North Minneapolis to which we currently maintain a vital support base. We retained our mobile Hope Baskets food and basic needs supplemental outreach program.
- 6) Spring 2011...The Onward Bound STEM Workshop Program was initiated to impact youth at Hennepin County Juvenile Detention Center into the CADD and 3D printing technology field. It is a youth career development program toward manufacturing.
- 7) Summer of 2014, the children's Onward Bound program teaches and mentors reading, writing, and child friendly MS Office technology skills to disadvantaged children.
